

Activity 1: Meet Our Fairies

Show students pictures of the IFLY fairies, read out their names to the class. Get students to discuss what they look like and get them to think about what sort of personality the fairy might have based on the picture they can see.

Ask the students if the fairy is giving any clues!

Activity 2: Fairy Character Description Writing

Students complete the fairy profile template to write character descriptions based on the fairy pictures have seen.

Activity 3: Read a Fairy Tale

Read a fairy tale of your choice. Throughout reading the story ask the students to identify and discuss the following:

- The hero in the story
- The morale of the story
- The villain in the story
- Is there a happy ending to the story?

Get students to think about their favourite fairy tales and think about who is in the story and why they love it so much. Is it the hero, the villain or do they just like that it has a happy ending?

Students then use the fairy story board template to come up with ideas for their own fairy tale.

Activity 4: Story Time

Students share their stories with the whole class. As a whole class pick 4 fairy tale stories that everyone likes.

Students are placed into 4 groups and given a character to act out in the story. Students spend time practising their play.

Activity 5: Play Time

Students use the fairy crown template to help make props for their play. They can also look for items in the classroom dress up box to add to their characters.

Activity 6: Performance

Students perform the play in front of the rest of the group of students in the class. Film the play so that the students can see their great acting skills later.
